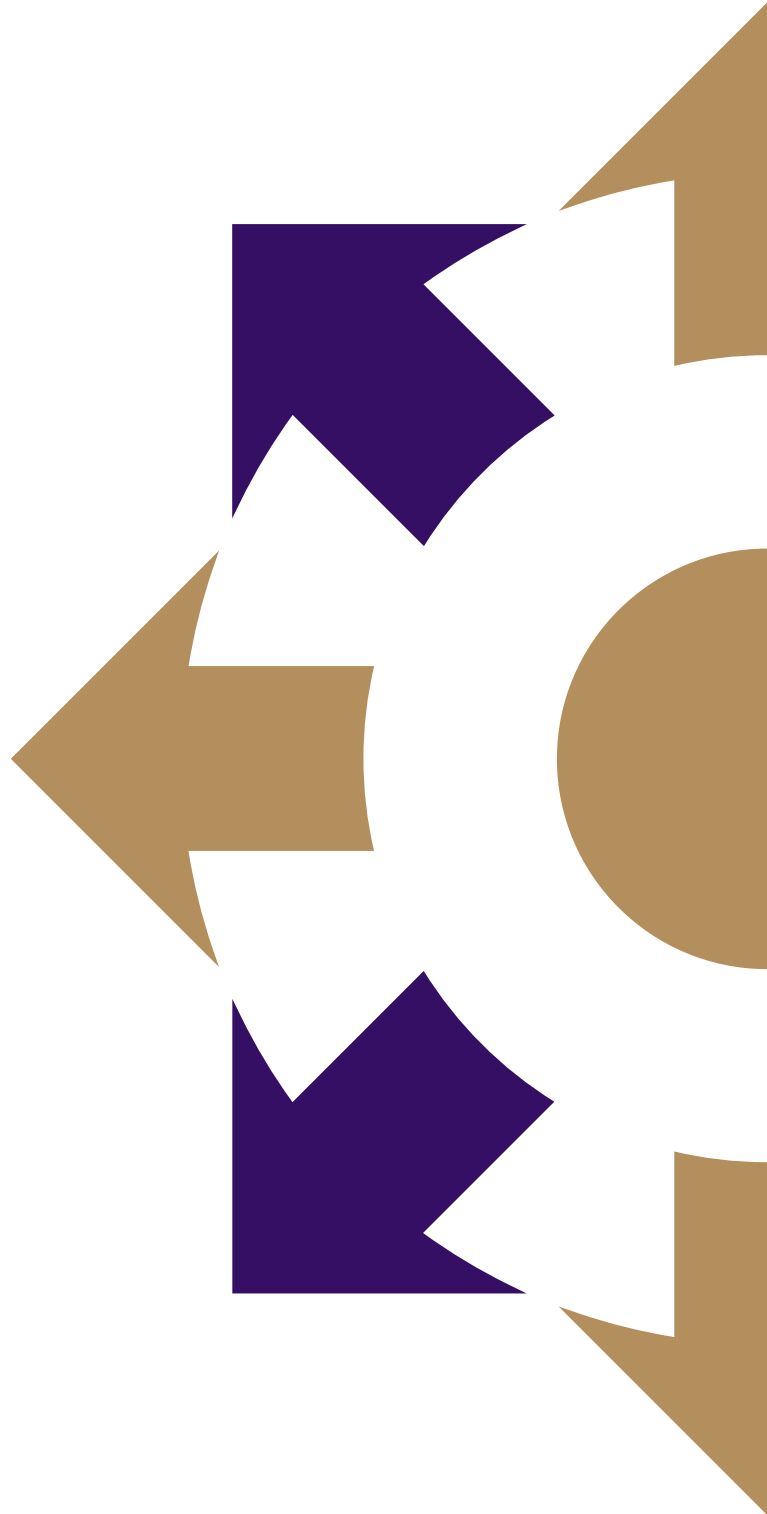

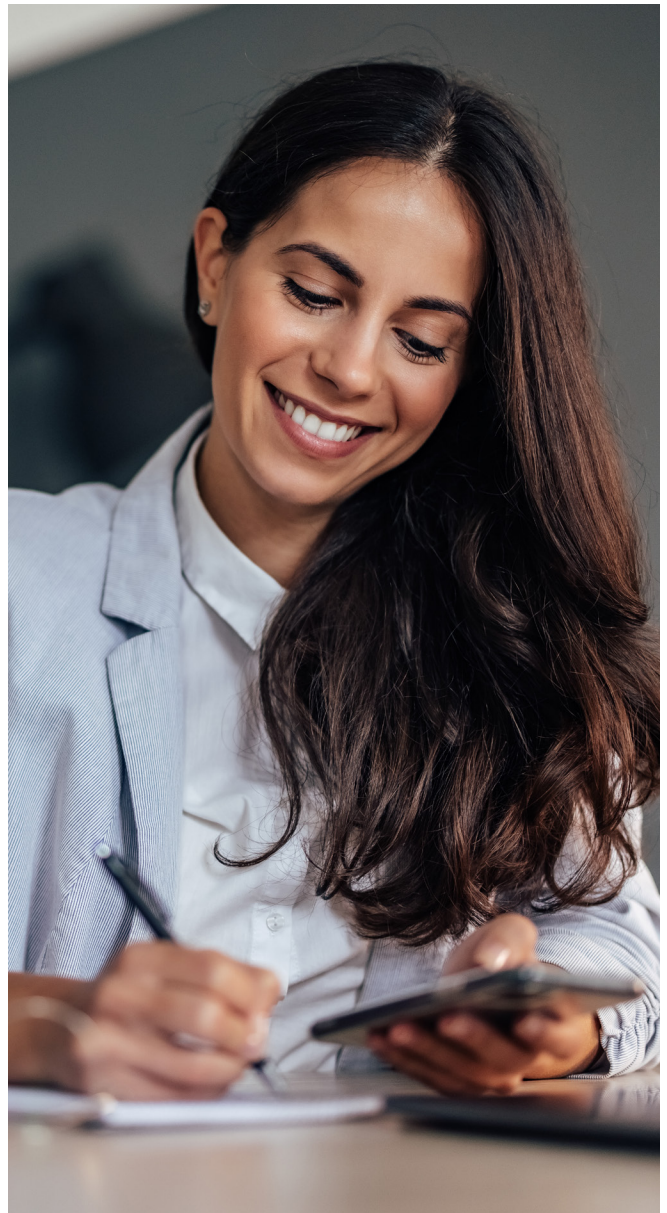

# CILT (UK) Level 3 Practitioners Certificate in Logistics, Supply Chain & Operations Management



## Overview

The CILT(UK) Level 3 Practitioners Certificate in Logistics, Supply Chain and Operations Management is a general certificate for those working in those areas across the supply chain and has been mapped to the CILT(UK) Competency Framework.

Its purpose is to develop a core understanding of the skills, knowledge and competencies required to operate along the supply chain; recognising the impact of organisational goals and available resources on the required outputs and deliverables within the context of logistics, supply chain and operations management.

## Qualification Structure

To achieve the certificate, Learners are required to successfully complete TWO mandatory (M) units and ONE optional (O) unit:

**Business Operations Along the Supply Chain (M)** introduces supply chain concepts and the interconnectivities of activity along global supply chains and positions them within the business operating environment.

**Cross-functional Interconnectivity (M)** focusses on the interactions of supply chain elements. Particular attention is given to inventory management processes, as well as the importance of defining and managing data and information along the supply chain.

**Production Operations Management (O)** considers the main focus of Operations Managers within a manufacturing environment. It looks to clarify the planning functions that support production, and the shop floor controls in place to facilitate the production process.

**Logistics and Supply Chain Operations (O)** explores the physical operations that occur along the supply chain, inclusive of physical inventory management, the handling and storage functions of the inventory within a warehouse and Distribution Centre.

# CILT(UK) Level 5 Professional Certificate in Supply Chain and Operations Management

## Overview

The CILT(UK) Level 5 Professional Certificate in Supply Chain and Operations Management is a general certificate for those influencing operations across the supply chain and has been mapped to the CILT(UK) Competency Framework.

Its purpose is to develop the underpinning skills, knowledge and competencies required to operate effectively along the supply chain; interpreting and proposing operational goals against strategic plans utilising available resources to support the achievement of the required outputs and deliverables within the context of supply chain and operations management.

## Qualification Structure

Learners are required to successfully complete all THREE of the following mandatory units:

**Business Environment and Strategic Thinking** explores the business environment within which supply chain operations function, considering the influences on activity and how strategic planning is applied to facilitate effective operations through informed decision making.

**Effective and Sustainable Resource Management** focusses on resources and sustainable practice. People are the lifeblood of any organisation and this module looks at the leadership functions that underpin an organisations ability to support their people in achieving operational goals and positioning business functions and resources to back this up.

**Business Planning** focusses on tactical and operational planning and controls along the supply chain; considering the impacts of demand, quality and cross-functional abilities that influence the tactical plans.

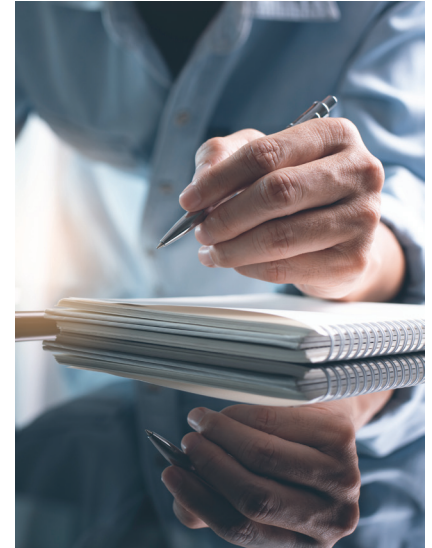

## Overview

The CILT(UK) Level 6 Advanced Professional Diploma in Supply Chain Networks is a comprehensive diploma for those working in those areas across the supply chain and has been mapped to the CILT(UK) Competency Framework.

The Professional Diploma explores the foundations from which strategic decision-making influences operational outputs. It considers the practical skills required to deliver transformational changes that support supply chain performance and resilience.

## Qualification Structure

Learners are required to successfully complete all THREE of the following mandatory units:

**Enhanced Supply Chain Capability** explores the effects of globalisation and its impacts on society, economy and culture, which is essential to individuals, businesses and policy makers to make informed decisions promoting sustainable network design and control within the supply chain.

**Performance Excellence** examines systematic ways to assess and improve various aspects of operations, to discern meaningful insights that affect decision-making; identifying areas for improvement and development to support future success.

**Navigating and Influencing Change** focusses investigating approaches to navigating the complexities of change in order to influence the success of transformative initiatives within their organisation

## CILT(UK) Professional Membership

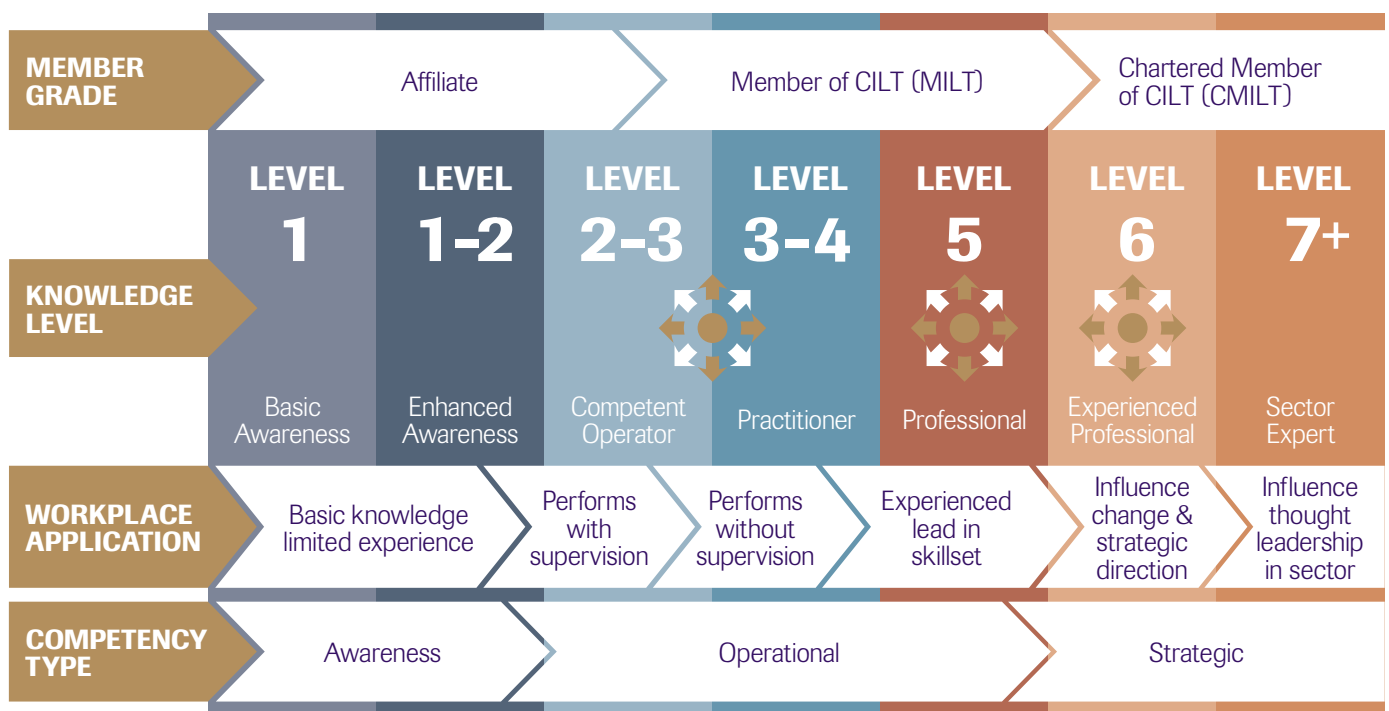
